How to book

Speak to your unit CO or Training Officer and ask them to book online via Westminster. Secure your place with a cheque made payable to MSSC and send it to the National Courses Office.

Course Information

Courses vary from two day weekend courses to a five day midweek course. They take place throughout the year including school holidays. We can help with travel costs and some expenses, please speak to the Courses Office for details.

Before each course you receive your joining instructions explaining what you need to bring (you might need a sleeping bag); what to expect and any other information relevant to the course.

Cost

You will normally pay £12 per day but there are discounts available for some unit and district camps or where more than one family member is attending. Please discuss with your CO or Training Officer.

CADET CENTRE, WEYMOUTH

A purpose built training centre close to the harbour and the venue for the 2012 Olympic Sailing Regatta. On the water you will learn to sail, drive powerboats and windsurf. Off the water you can study marine engineering to BTEC Level. The drill deck/sports hall has a 7.6m high, eight route climbing wall and an indoor shooting range.
